


Typhoon Soulik Approaching the Korean Peninsula

Typhoon Preparedness Tips

- ✓ **For your safety, stay indoors until typhoon warning released**
- ✓ Continue listening to the radio or TV for the latest updates.
- ✓ Tape up your windows to protect from a typhoon.
- ✓ Prepare flashlights and batteries, or candles in case of a blackout

Citizens living in areas that are at risk of floods or landslides should be prepared with evacuation routes and emergency contacts.



Make sure that doors and windows are firmly closed so that they do not waver or break. For your safety, stay inside your house



Do not walk or drive vehicles on roads that are under water



Citizens of underground areas or dilapidated dwellings that have the risk of collapsing should evacuate to a safe location



Do not go near construction areas as they are dangerous



Do not go near the surface of slopes where a landslide might occur
