

English Language Proficiency (ELP) Requirement

Applicants must demonstrate proficiency in English in one of the following ways if their first language (learned and understood) is not English.

CanTEST (Canadian Test of English for Scholars and Trainees)	4.5 overall min.

- » App-operated laundry facilities



Personal training


Achieve your fitness goals with the help of an experienced, certified personal trainer.
