Pre-arrival Information

Spring Semester 2020

This pre-arrival information includes crucial information that will help you prepare your departure for Ajou!

■ Applying for Student Visa (D-2-6)

All international exchange students are required to obtain D-2-6 (exchange) visa for their study at Ajou. In order to obtain a D-2-6 visa, you must submit the required documents to the Korean Embassy or Consulate in your country.

These documents have been sent to your home university or to the confirmed address via post.

- (1) Certificate of Admission
- (2) Invitation Letter
- (3) Certificate of Business Registration of Ajou University
- (4) Certificate of Scholarship (if applicable)

The application procedure and required documents may vary depending on the embassy or consulate, so it is advised that you check with your local Korean embassy or consulate beforehand. Please note that you need to sign the Certificate of Admission issued by Ajou University before submitting it to the embassy.

If you have already obtained another type of visa, you **must** change it to **D-2-6**. The duration of the visa is determined by the Korean consular officer, and the expiration date on your visa may not match the end date of your program. If your visa expires before you complete your tasks, you will need to apply for a visa extension at the Korean Immigration Office.

Required documents may be added or changed depending on individual circumstances. For more information, please visit the Korean immigration website – Hi Korea (E-Government for Foreigners) at www.hikorea.go.kr.

■ Health and Medical Clearance Form

All students have been requested to submit the health and medical clearance form with their online application as part of the required documents. However, if it is not submitted upon application, students will need to get re-tested for tuberculosis at the district public health center in Korea upon arrival. Please note that the OIA will submit your tuberculosis test result to the Office of Student Housing & Residence at Ajou University **at once** so individual submission will not be necessary. Furthermore, please note that according to the government regulation, students from certain designated countries, listed below, are required to submit TB test result upon their D-2-6 *visa application*.

The designated 19 countries are: *Cambodia, Myanmar, the Philippines, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Mongolia, Indonesia, India, Nepal, Vietnam, Thailand, Russia, Malaysia, Uzbekistan, China, Sri Lanka, East Timor, Kyrgyzstan, Laos*

■ Dormitory Application

The application will be available online at Ajou website: <http://edorm.ajou.ac.kr>

The application period is from **January 13rd ~ 19th, 2020** and you will need to input the following for a successful application:

- 1) Your registered email address (upon your online application)
- 2) Ajou student ID number as the *application ID*

You can find your student ID number and the registered email address in the attached Letter of Invitation.

Please note that housing applications after the application period will not be accepted, and, unfortunately, we cannot guarantee your placement. You will be able to access the final room assignment in *early* August after the successful completion of your housing registration.

University dormitory will open on **February 24th, 2020** for new coming students for the Spring semester 2020 so please set your flight schedule to arrive after February 24th. Unfortunately, it is not possible to move in to the dormitory *before* the dormitory opening date. For your information, the dormitory office will be open from 9 a.m. to 10 p.m. for check-in so you will have to arrive on campus by 9 p.m. at the latest to complete the check-in procedure.

The dormitory will close on **June 20th, 2020** and if a student moves out of the dormitory after the closing date, the student is responsible for checking the availability to stay with the dormitory coordinator, and should pay any extra charges according to the dorm regulation.

■ Course Registration

Course registration will be available online from **February 18th to February 19th, 2020**. The tentative course list will be announced on our website in late January, and the **final list** will be uploaded in **around the first or second week of February** before the official course registration.

Meanwhile, you may refer to the course list offered in the **Spring and Fall semester 2019** on our website as similar courses are offered on each corresponding semester.

- **Course Registration: Feb. 18th (Tue.) – 19th (Wed.), 2020**
- **Course Change: Mar. 2nd (Mon.) **and** Mar. 3rd (Tue.), 2020**
- **Course Withdrawal: Mar. 19th (Thurs.) – Mar. 20th (Fri), 2020**

Please note that you can **add and drop** courses during the course changing period. Also, we would like to inform you that you can **only withdraw from one course** during the course withdrawal period, so please avoid registering irrelevant courses during the course registration.

※ The above schedule is subject to change and the final schedule will be noticed via email in *early* August.

■ Arrival to Ajou University from Incheon Int'l Airport

Airport pick-up service

The airport pick-up service is available **only** for students who apply in advance. The service is available for two days, **between 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Feb. 24th (Mon.) and Feb. 25th (Tue.), 2020, only at the Incheon International Airport.**

In order to use this service, you need to complete the survey below **by no later than February 16th, 2020**: <https://ko.surveymonkey.com/r/airportspring2020>

Ajou students will pick you up from the airport. When you arrive at the airport, please **wait** for the A.G.A. students (Ajou Global Ambassador: student volunteer group) at either of the following designation depending on your flight's arrival terminal:

- 1) Terminal 1: inside of Exit No. 8. on the 1st floor**
- 2) Terminal 2: next to the escalators no. 5 and 6 (Please don't leave the airport)**

A.G.A. students will be holding an "Ajou University" sign and will guide you to the limousine bus heading to Ajou University, and at the bus stop, A.G.A. students will help you to take a taxi to the university dormitory. You have to pay your own transportation fee, so please prepare some cash (KRW 20,000/about USD 20) in advance.

If you miss A.G.A. students (due to late arrival at Incheon airport (i.e. flight delay), or by providing us incorrect information), you will need to come to Ajou University on your own.

Students arriving on their own

Please refer to the information below for directions from Incheon International Airport to Ajou University. If you are staying in the dormitory, please go directly to the dormitory and check in with the dormitory coordinator.

1. Arrival at Incheon International Airport (International Arrival)
2. Terminal 1 : Go to EXIT No. 8 on the 1st floor and take the bus no. A4000 at the station 8A
3. Terminal 2 : Take the escalators no. 5 and 6 and take the bus at the station '31-41'
4. Airport limousine bus : "no. A4000" toward "East Suwon"
5. Fare : KRW 12,000, approx. USD 10.
6. Get off at the last bus stop, "Hotel Castle"
7. Take a taxi to Ajou University from Hotel Castle (about 5,000 Won/ USD 5)

■ Health Insurance Policy at Ajou

All incoming exchange & visiting students studying at Ajou University are obligated to obtain personal health insurance as a condition of admission. Students must purchase an insurance for the full study period, including periods of travel before and after their exchange period at Ajou University.

Please enroll in a health insurance plan of your choice, but it is recommended that you choose a study abroad plan which will cover medical expenses to be incurred during your exchange in Korea. Please refer to the chart below of the general insurance plan for the international students. Mandatory insurance plans provided at your home institution will be sufficient, but proof (an official letter) must be provided. You can also enroll in a health insurance plan in Korea at the Ajou University for your convenience.

Students should purchase their health insurance before their arrival to Korea, and must upload a copy of the insurance contract through the link below by **Feb. 14th, 2020**. Please note that if you were unsuccessful accessing the Google Survey, please make sure to send a copy of your health insurance via incoming@ajou.ac.kr.

If a student does not submit a copy of the health insurance, the issuance of documents such as transcripts, Certificate of Enrollment, etc., will be restricted.

■ Alien Registration

Foreigners staying in Korea for more than 90 days must register for the alien registration at a local immigration office within 90 days from the date of entry. Simply receiving your visa is not the last step to registration, and those with visas must receive an ARC (Alien registration card) to finalize their sojourn documentation. **It is illegal to stay in Korea for more than 90 days without being registered, regardless of your visa at entry.**

The required documents for your ARC application is as below:

- 1) Application Form
- 2) Copy of Passport
- 3) 1 color head shot photos (3.5 * 4.5 cm)
- 4) Application fee: KRW 30,000
- 5) Medical check-up record for tuberculosis from students from the countries below:
 - (19 countries) *Cambodia, Myanmar, the Philippines, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Mongolia, Indonesia, India, Nepal, Vietnam, Thailand, Russia, Malaysia, Uzbekistan, China, Sri Lanka, East Timor, Kyrgyzstan, Laos*
 - Students of the nationalities above are required to submit the medical check-up report including the examination for tuberculosis issued from a neighborhood public health center.

Note: The incoming coordinator will collect your documents and submit them to the Suwon Immigration Office at once, and we would like to remind you that it usually takes about 3~5 weeks for the immigration office to process the issuance of your ARC application.

■ Meals & Food

Students can buy various types of meals on and off-campus, and also cook some instant snacks in the shared kitchen of the dormitory. Students usually use the kitchen to cook noodles, toast, and small snacks or to keep their own food in the communal refrigerator. Normal meal prices range from 3,500 won to 5,000 won (approx. USD 3 ~ 5) per meal on campus.

■ Student ID card

Your student ID Card will be distributed from the Office of International Affairs (Yulgok #312) upon your arrival.

■ To open a bank account

If you would like to open a bank account in Korea, you will need the Alien Registration card and your passport.

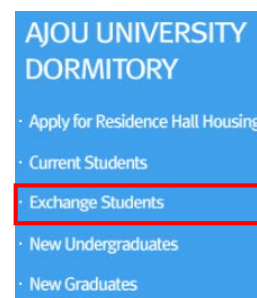

1. For your application, please log in at the **online** housing application system web page: <http://www.ajou.ac.kr/edorm/>

2. Please click "Exchange Students" at the left banner of the webpage.



The housing application will be open **from January 13th (Mon.) to 19th (Sun.), 2020**.

Please use the student ID given by Ajou University and the registered email address you entered on the application. Please note that the email address should be exactly the **same** as the one registered during your online application.

Housing Application Procedure

Only for new coming students

All new Ajou International Students should apply for the dormitory online and international Students can only stay at Hwahong Hall and the International Dormitory. Instructions are as follows:

* Please pay the dorm fee at the KB Bank on Ajou campus **after** arriving at Korea. If you cannot arrive at Ajou by **Feb. 24th (Tue.)**, you should inform to a dormitory coordinator and transfer the dorm fee by the date of **Feb. 24th (Tue.), 2020**. If you do not move in without paying by the due date without any notice, your application will be cancelled.

* Please check that you can be arranged in a 2-bed room even though you apply for the 4-bed room due to the lack of 4 bed-rooms.

3. Submission of Health Check-up result

Before moving in to the dorm, all residents should submit the result of the health check-up (especially for tuberculosis result).

If all incoming exchange & visiting students have already submitted the health check-up result to the Office of International Affairs (OIA), the OIA will forward it to the Office of Student Housing & Residence at once.

❖ If you didn't submit the health check-up result yet, please email it to the OIA as soon as possible, and please note that without the result, students cannot move in.

- a) If residents need to leave during the middle of the semester, residents should apply for refund request, the same procedure as dormitory application.
- b) The dormitory fee will be refunded to the student according to the refund policy.
- c) The criteria of refund policy are based on the move-in date given by the dormitory, not by the individual students' actual move-in date.
- d) Residents who are expelled due to violation of dormitory rules and regulations will receive **NO REFUND**
- e) Summer or winter vacation residents will receive NO REFUND for early withdrawal from the dormitory.

5. Important Notice

- a) Due to limited availability, room arrangement *cannot be guaranteed as your preference* and your room can be changed even though it was assigned.
- b) If you do not apply for the dormitory within the application period, the application cannot be acceptable.
- c) If you don't pay the bill by the due date, your application will be cancelled without further notice.
- d) Every resident should *submit the result of a TB check* (Tuberculosis) sheet before moving in. The OIA will submit the Exchange Students' TB result at once to dormitory.
- e) If you leave your stuff in a room without applying for the dormitory, it will be cleared out. You are responsible for your own belongings, nobody can be responsible for them.
- f) Dormitory offers bedding sets (a temporary pillow, blanket and bed sheet) for only international students from at the inspector office in each dorm 1st floor.
- g) Please note the move out day, and remember to leave the dorm accordingly. If you move in earlier or stay after the move-out date, you have to pay a fine (5 times the one-day fee, approx. KRW 50,000 ~ 80,000)

Requirement for International Students

1. Eligibility to Move In

- A. Incoming international students
- B. Registered international students
 - 1) Excluding those who were on academic probation in the previous semester
 - 2) Excluding those who were given 30 points' penalties and expelled from the dormitory
 - 3) Excluding research students

2. Selection Criteria

- A. The resident selection shall take place every semester.
- B. Incoming students will be given priority.
- C. Selection criteria for currently registered students
 - 1) Currently registered students will be selected after the spots for incoming students are filled.
 - 2) The same selection criteria will be applied to currently registered students as follows.
(GPA: 60 percent; basic points: 30 percent; service points: 10 percent)
 - 3) If multiple students with same GPA's and credits compete for one vacancy, the date of birth (the youngest person will be given priority) will be taken into consideration.
 - 4) Currently registered students must move out of their rooms prior to the beginning of the semester if not selected. Unless selected students make full payment by the deadline, the vacancies will be given to those next in line on the waiting list.

3. Room Assignment Guidelines

- A. Room assignment will be handled by the Office of Student Housing & Residence with full consideration of applicants' requests.
- B. The request period for room changes will be the first week of each semester. No change is allowed after the period.
- C. Students suffering from sleep disorders (snoring, teeth grinding, etc.) serious enough to disturb roommates cannot be accepted.
- D. Students can choose from the two types of rooms: two-bed rooms and four-bed rooms. However, if there aren't any remaining rooms, the Office of Student Housing & Residence will randomly assign the rooms. *If there is a lack of 4-bed room, the Office of Student Housing & Residence will arrange a 2-bed room.*
- E. As for registered students, rooms will be allocated in accordance with GPA.
- F. Students will be categorized into groups of Undergraduate, Graduate School, Exchange Student, etc. when allocating the rooms

4. Dormitory Application Procedures

- A. The dormitory application submission period for international students will be the same as local students
- B. No application allowed after the deadline

Housing Agreement

All residents should abide by the rules and regulations of the Ajou University Dormitory. These rules and regulations have been set forth for the purpose of promoting the convenience, security and welfare of the residents of our dormitory, and to protect the dormitory's property from misuse and abuse. Any violations against the rules and regulations will result in penalties as follows.

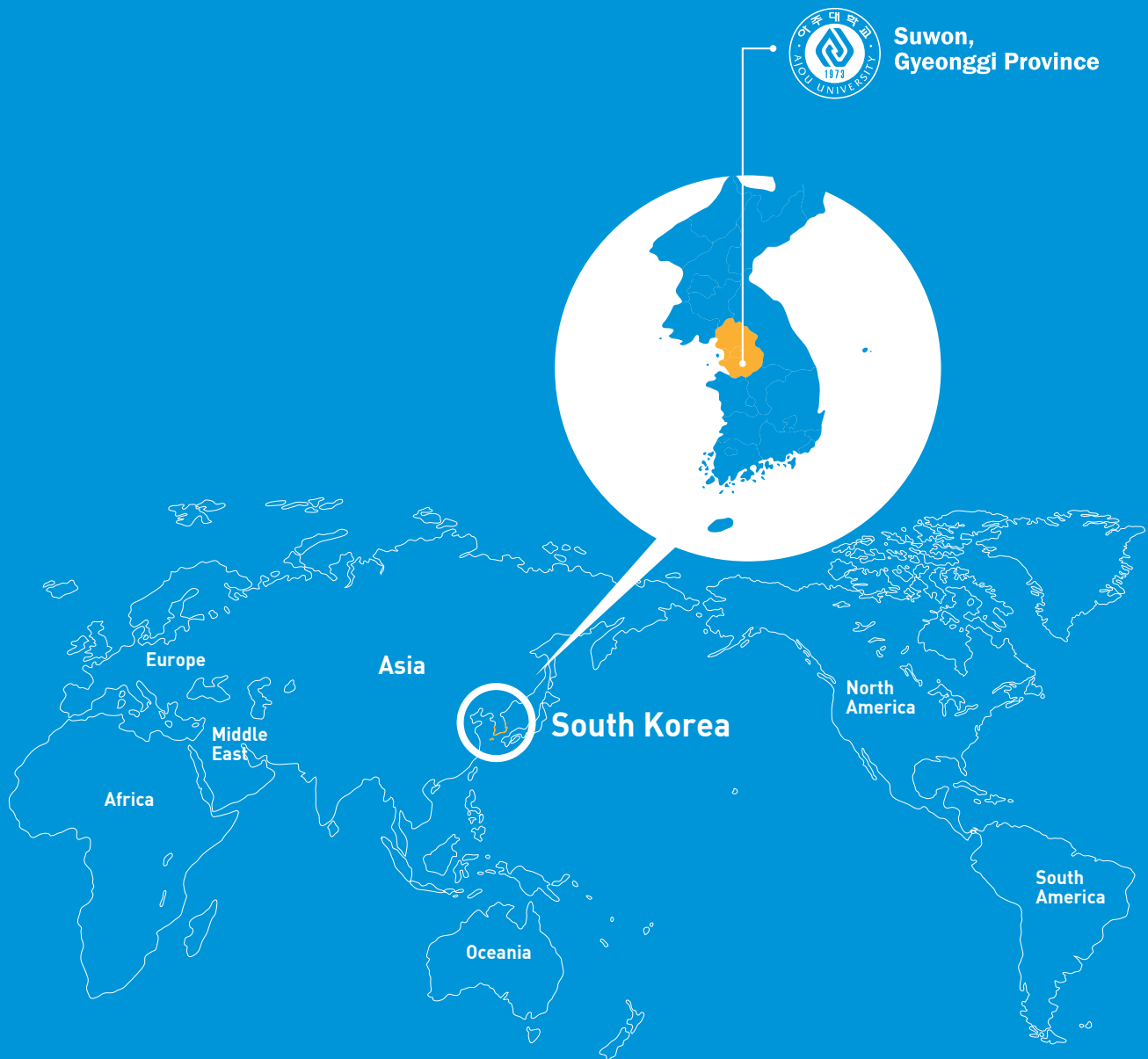
