

Application for Change of the Degree Process to Integrated Course for Students under the Master's Degree Course, 2025 Fall

Those who want to change the degree course to the Integrated Course, among students under the Master's degree course in the graduate school, need to submit an application form within the designated period as below.

1. Qualification

- a. Enrolled students who completed one or more semesters at the said graduate school
- b. Those who got recommendation from Academic Advisor

2. Application Date : 2025.05.30(FRI) 09:00 ~ 06.12(THU)17:00

3. Required Documents

- a. One application form : Attachment #1
- b. An original copy of Transcripts

4. Place for Submission : Office of Graduate School (Yulgok #305)

5. Admission Screening : Documents screening and Interview (The date for the interview may vary by department)

6. Application fee : Exempt

7. Notes

- a. Recruiting departments are vary. Only departments with the Integrated Course are open to students
- b. No limit to the number of submission
- c. Procedure of Admission Decision : Same as schedule of application for admission for Fall, 2025
- d. Credit recognition : Possible to earn the credits acquired in the Master's course
- e. Qualification for Conferment of Degree
 - 1) A student who has completed the registration of 8 semesters or more
 - The years required for completing a course of study can be reduced by 1 year (2 semesters)
 - 2) A student who has completed both major credits and research credits under the prescribed curriculum
***The credits for completing major and research subjects within the total credit range vary by admission year and department, so please refer to the criteria for completion of Attachment #3**
 - 3) A student with Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better
 - 4) A student who passed the paper screening and qualifying examination (Foreign Language test and comprehensive examination)
